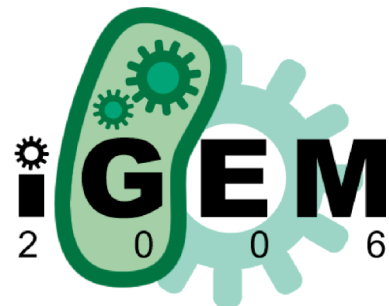

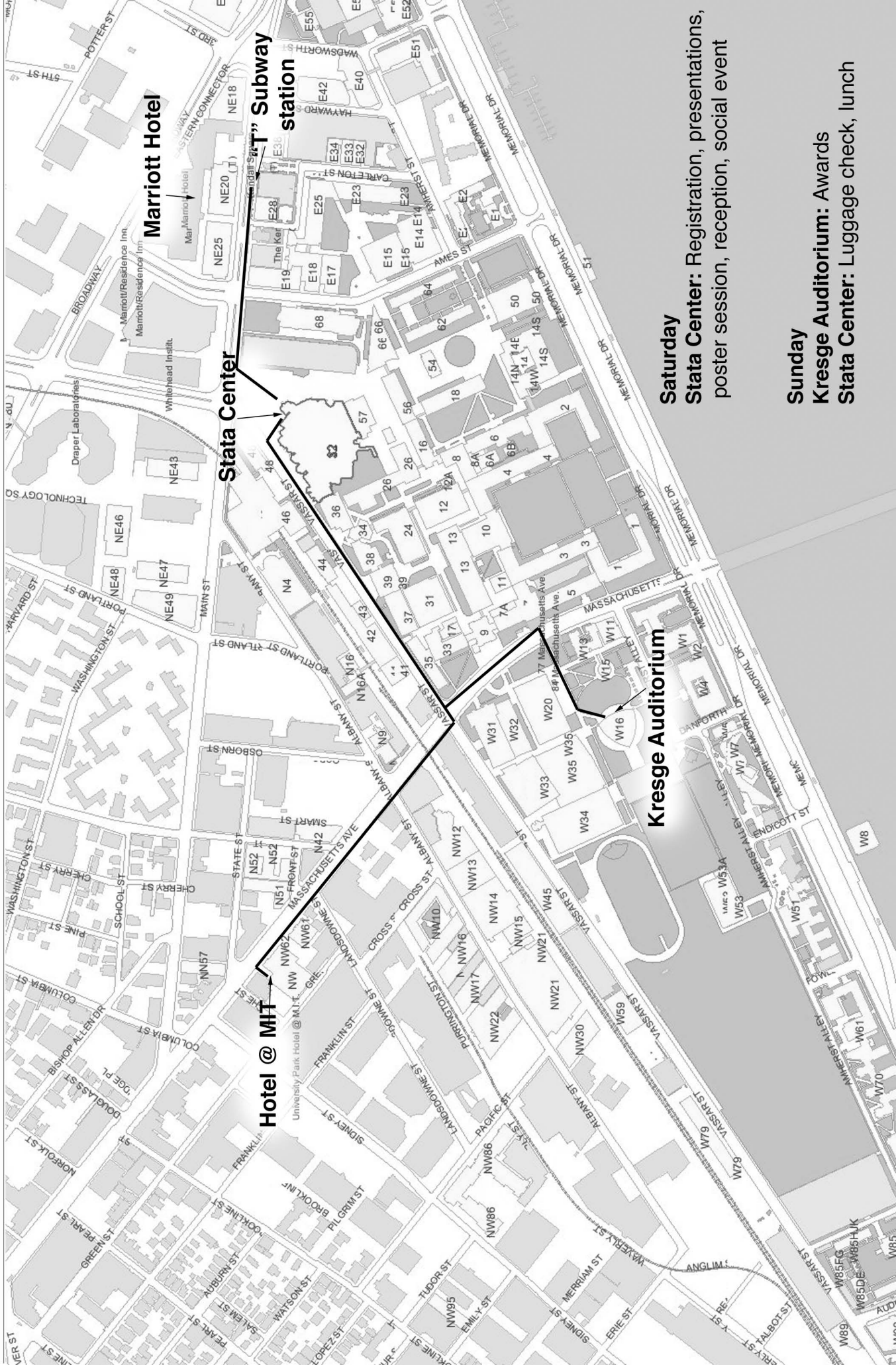

How-to-Connect to MIT Wireless Internet

How to register without an IP address (faculty, staff, students and visitors)

1. Start up your computer:

Wireless DHCP Service: Turn on your device. (For laptops, make sure the wireless card is enabled.) Confirm that you are located in a wireless zone.

Note: Windows users should go to Preventing Reinfection During Cleanup of Your Windows Machine (instructions apply to non-infected machines as well) prior to proceeding.

2. Make sure your computer is set to obtain IP address automatically.

3. Start up your web browser.

Result: The Welcome page displays.

4. Click on your status type.

Result: Depending upon the status type, one of the following pages displays:

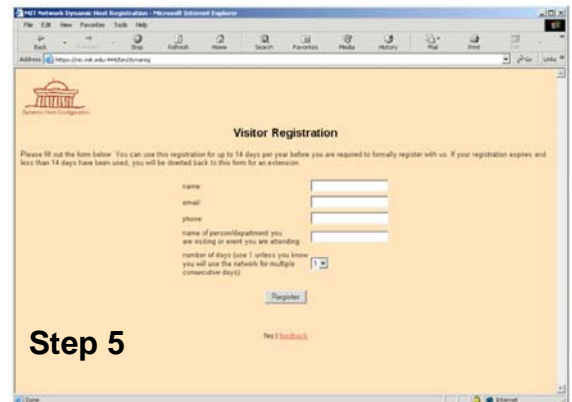

5. Read the instructions, then click Register.

Result: Depending upon your status type, one of the following pages displays:

- Visitors



6. Fill in the requested information, then click Register.
(Information needed:

- Name
- Email address
- Phone number
- Name of person/department you are visiting or event that you are attending
- Number of days needed)

Result: The Registration successfully completed page displays.

It will take approximately 15–30 minutes for the process to complete. Make sure you clear out your browser cache before attempting to connect via DHCP.
